Last fall we ran a Yuletide Sing Program which gave participants a chance to try barbershop singing at no cost and without any obligation to continue. Program participants learned 8 holiday favourites and performed them with the chorus at our Christmas show. Several participants decided to continue with the chorus while others were happy to sing with the chorus but did not continue. The program provided a good opportunity to learn about the chorus and barbershop singing in a relaxed setting and then to experience the joy of performing for friends and family. It is likely we will repeat the Yuletide Sing Program in fall 2024. We were pleased to recognize several individuals who were key players in starting and running the event for many years. This year's Niagara Barbershoppers Corn Roast is Saturday, August 17, 2024. It is with great sadness we extend our condolences to families and friends on the passing of Larry Sheehan. He was a long time member of ACN who brought humour and commitment to the chorus. He will be missed.

While sharing its love of song, A Cappella Niagara raises funds to support charities such as **Harmonize for Speech**, which helps children who have speech impediments, and **Sing Canada Harmony**, which supports equal access to vocal music for Canadians of all ages. Each year we contribute 10% of the proceeds from our annual show to one of these national foundations or a local charity. MEET OUR MUSIC DIRECTOR Jim McConachie

Like many of us, Jim got his introduction to vocal music through the primary and secondary school systems. Singing in school choirs led to participation in Broadway style and Gilbert and Sullivan productions and then to a college level jazz choir. After school, a move to Burlington to start a career as a paramedic brought Jim into touch with barbershop harmony.

'Roadshow' – the Burlington barbershop harmony chorus – was a natural move. Jim sang with the chorus and with several quartets in that chapter. After several years with

the chorus, Jim took on the role of performance coach for the group and helped the music team take the chorus to several Ontario District Championships.

A job move in 2001 took Jim to Grey County Paramedic Services, where he became the music director of 'Encore!' – the Owen Sound barbershop harmony chorus. Under Jim's leadership, 'Encore!' grew from a small group of ten or so into a thriving chorus of thirty men. They quickly became one of the more popular vocal ensembles in the Grey/Bruce region.

Retirement and a return to the Burlington area seemed a perfect time to join A Cappella Niagara as music director. He is enjoying his work with our chorus to develop an entertaining musical performance package.


Over the course of several years, Jim has studied choral direction and vocal performance at the Barbershop Harmony Society's summer college program at Missouri Western State College. His quartet accomplishments include several chapter level quartets, top five finishes in District and International Preliminary contests with 'Q. E. Connection' and most recently top ten finishes in International Preliminary contests with 'Three'.

Jim and his partner Jennifer enjoy snowboarding in winter, sea kayaking and camping in summer, and have taken up the sport of wine hunting in the between seasons.

MEET OUR ASSISTANT MUSIC DIRECTOR Phil Sheehan

I grew up in a home full of Music. My mother Mary (Howe) Sheehan was a singer, teacher, and a children's choral director. She became the first Musical Director for the Separate School board of St. Catharines.

I became aware of Barbershop music from an ad my Wife Mary brought home from Bob Laing's Pharmacy in Fonthill. It sat on my desk for a year



before I attended my first rehearsal, and the harmony hooked me immediately. Like most involved, I wished I had started years before.

I have been singing with A Cappella Niagara since I started about 24 years ago. I also sang with the Batavia and Buffalo NY choruses and won the Senaca Land District championship twice allowing us to compete in Kansas City and Philadelphia.

I've sung in a few quartets including Forward Motion, New York Minute, Central Park, and Heritage. New York Minute won the Senaca Land District senior quartet championship and Heritage won the Ontario District senior championship. I usually sing lead but in one quartet I tried baritone, which is a true test of whether one can sing harmony.

I attended a few directors workshops in Ontario and the Level One class at Harmony University in Nashville, TN. I enjoy directing and find I learn a great deal by observing other directors; and, of course, actually directing our chorus when given the opportunity. In my new position as Assistant Director I'm working on learning our chapter repertoire. Thanks Mom.

Since its founding, A Cappella Niagara (ACN) has shared the joy of singing with the community by performing at places and events such as the St. Catharines Hospital, Santa Claus parades, the Candlelight Stroll in Niagara-on-the-Lake, malls, and retirement homes. ACN has participated in the Festival of Lights and the Queen Victoria Park stage in Niagara Falls. In Fonthill, chapter quartets have performed at the 'Christmas in Pelham' and the chorus and quartets have sung at 'Summerfest' and the 'Concert Series.' Other singouts include the M&M Fund Raiser for Crohn's disease and Colitis in St. Catharines, the Fort Erie Optimist Club Fund Raiser and a concert for the St. Andrews Presbyterian Church in Welland. ACN performed for the C.D. Howe Institute banquet in Niagara-on-the-Lake and at the Welland Community Wellness Centre summer series.

In 2015 ACN became the organizer and host for the Niagara Barbershoppers Annual Corn Roast, which was started and run by the Singing Saints for 45 years. The Corn Roast, which raises funds for the Niagara Children's Centre, takes place every August in St. Catharines.


